The name Soroptimist means "best for women," and that's what the organization strives to achieve. We are women at our best, working to help other women to be *their* best.

Soroptimist is an international volunteer organization for women who work to improve the lives of women and children, in local communities and throughout the world.

Soroptimist members belong to local clubs, which determine the focus of their work in their communities. Club projects range from renovating domestic violence shelters and providing mammograms to low-income women, to sponsoring self-esteem workshops for teenage girls, and teen dating violence prevention resources.

Our major project is the Soroptimist Women's Opportunity Award. It assists women who provide the primary source of financial support for their families by giving them the resources they need to improve their education, skills, and employment prospects.

Each year, more than \$1.5 million is disbursed through cash awards at various levels of the organization. Recipients, who often have overcome enormous obstacles including poverty, domestic violence, and drug and alcohol abuse, may use the awards to offset any costs associated with their efforts to attain higher education, such as books, childcare, and transportation.
